Who we are

Statewide Civics Education Program

We offer our programs to any school in Ohio. Our programs are designed for 3rd - 12th grade classrooms. All of our programs are free and accessible online.

State Affiliate of Kids Voting USA

We are a state affiliate of KVUSA. KVUSA has been in existence since the 1980s and has over 30 affiliates across the country. KVUSA's mission is to create lifelong voting habits in children, increase family communication about citizenship, and encourage greater adult voter turnout.

Non-Profit, Non-Partisan

Kids Voting Ohio is a 501(c)3 non-profit. Our Board of directors is made up of Ohio Educators and Administrators. We are also a nonpartisan organization solely focused on civics education.

- help determine questions, topics, ideas for discussion

- partake in an advisory board and help create a youth agenda for the candidates.
